



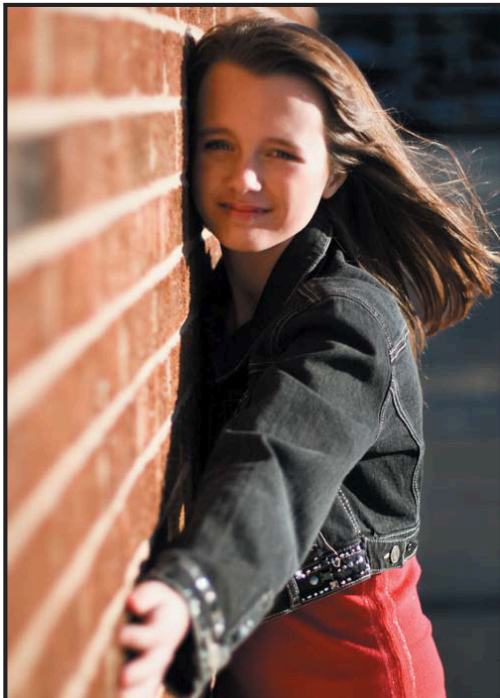
Bria Kelly

I first met Bria a little over a year ago, just before her 12th birthday. I had no idea at the time just what a treat I was in for. Then I heard her sing, and at once started looking around to see who was singing; after all, that kind of power couldn't possibly be coming from that tiny little girl, but it was.

I've since heard Bria sing pop, country, rock and even blues and she does a great job on all of them - she's even written a few songs of her own.

Bria has a pretty impressive background for one so young. Some of her accomplishments include:

Bria won the Philadelphia Eagles' National Anthem competition in 2007, and got to sing at one of their games in front of 45,000 fans. She has also performed the Anthem for the Washington Redskins, numerous local sports teams, and the Air Force and Navy. Collectively, she has performed the Anthem over 28 times to a combined audience of over 185,000 people.

In addition, Bria has been featured locally in the Smithfield Times, the Virginian-Pilot and the Daily Press.

In March 2007, Bria joined several members of the former Radio Disney "RD7" pop group to form a new group, called "No Limit". "No Limit" was a group of three singers and two dancers, ages 12-15, and Bria performed with them throughout all of 2007. Bria left No Limit in April, 2008 to pursue a solo singing career.

Since then, she has been keeping very busy – in fact, she sang the Anthem at a 9/11/2008 remembrance at the Virginia Beach Amphitheater just before Taylor Swift and Rascal Flatts took to the stage – there were 18,000 people at this one concert!

Bria is also a guest vocalist with the Grant Austin Taylor Band, singing selections such as "Steamroller Blues", "Angel from Montgomery", "Collide", and "Teardrops On My Guitar". She is also learning to play the guitar and is coming along quite well!
